

Car Emergency Kit

- Keep the Fuel tank at $\frac{1}{2}$ locally and $\frac{3}{4}$ on Highways.
- All insurance and ID information
- A properly inflated spare tire, wheel wrench, and tripod jack
- Empty one-gallon gas can
- Jumper cables
- Jumper Box (that is also a battery pack for the phone)
- Tool kit and/or a multipurpose utility tool
- Pruning Saw
- Flashlight and extra batteries (Solar or mechanical charge)
- Real Road Flares (these can be used as fire starters in a pinch)
- Reflective triangles and brightly colored cloth to make your vehicle more visible
- Compass
- Emergency Weather Radio (solar or manual charge)
- IFAK with Trauma Bandage, Tourniquet Chest Seal Hemostatic Agent BLEED STOP
- BOO BOO First aid kit with gauze, tape, bandages, antibiotic ointment, aspirin, a blanket, non-latex gloves, scissors, hydrocortisone, thermometer, tweezers, and instant cold compress
- Nonperishable, high-energy foods, such as unsalted nuts, dried fruits, and hard candy
- Drinking water
- Reflective vest in case you need to walk to get help
- Car charger for your cell phone
- Fire extinguisher
- Duct tape Gorilla Brand
- Multiple sizes of ZIP Ties
- Rain poncho Recommend Military style with Poncho liner or Woobie. Makes a great sleeping bag
- Additional items for cold weather include a snow brush, Mini shovel, windshield washer fluid, warm clothing, cat litter for traction, and Wool blankets

Additional Items for the hardcore

- 2-3 10 hr bees wax candles
- Old coffee can
- 32oz single wall stainless steel water bottle and 750 ml nesting cup
- Shelter kit
